- Only effective if people bring information
- Order of reporting: ■
 - Medical Examiner/Coroner
 - EMS/Fire
 - Law Enforcement
 - Health Care Providers
 - Social Services
 - Public Health
 - Prosecuting Attorney
 - Others

 - What more do we need to know?
 - Should we make improvements to our investigative system?





Services

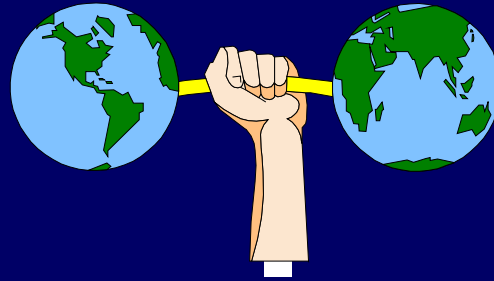
- Were services provided?
