



DATA SOURCES

The following table provides a list of data sources necessary for conducting a productive review and answering all questions about a case in the CDR-CRS. Teams with members from a variety of disciplines may have an easier time obtaining records by going through the representative on the team. It is important to note that a given data source may or may

not have the information requested by the CDR-CRS. In this instance, it may be beneficial to discuss adding items to the original data sources to ensure the information is captured in a systematic way. Additionally, placing the data collected for each case in the context of other information about local communities including social determinants of health is essential.
