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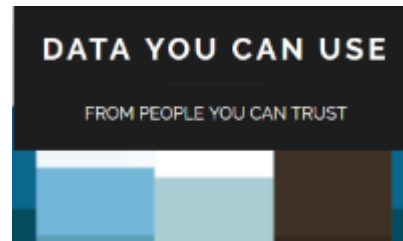

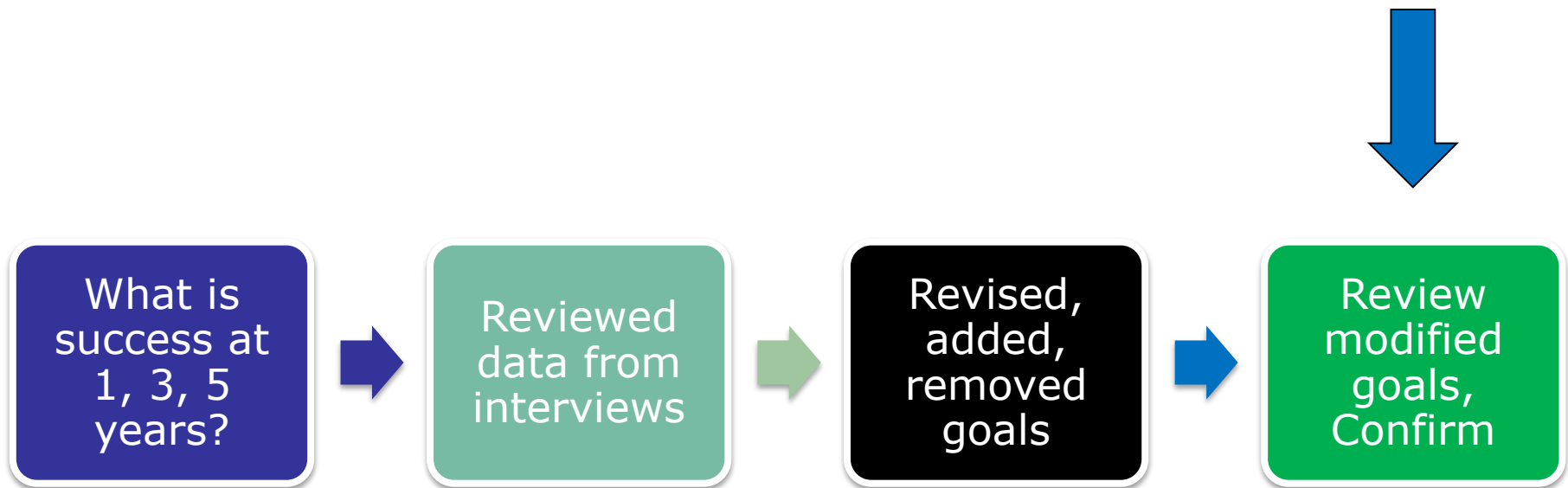

Year One Goals

- E. Children and families receive healthy food at pantries (Choice Pantry)
