ASTHMA

GOAL

Improve asthma management

PRIORITY ACTIVITIES

- Build support for Medicaid reimbursement and private pay of asthma education and home-based services
- Educate health care providers to appropriately utilize the national asthma guidelines

Improve school readiness

EMERGENCY CARE

GOAL

Improve pediatric emergency care prehospital and in hospital

GRIEF AND BEREAVEMENT

GOAL

Ensure all families experiencing a sudden unexpected infant death (SUID) have access to support and services

INJURY PREVENTION AND DEATH REVIEW

GOAL

Reduce injuries and deaths

- Shared plan of care pilot projects with families and care teams

PRIORITY ACTIVITIES

- Increase dental care for pregnant women
- Educate medical and dental providers on the need for dental care during pregnancy
