

GRIEF AND BEREAVEMENT

Ensure all families experiencing a sudden unexpected infant death (SUID) have access to support and services

KEY INDICATORS

1 Increase outreach to families experiencing a SUID by 30%

Baseline: 65% (2014)

Measure: Vital statistics record of death and Infant Death Center database

Increase number of counties offering grief and bereavement services in Support Directory by 15%

Baseline: 42% (2014)

Measure: Infant Loss Support Directory

Baseline: 90% (2013)

Measure: Wisconsin Public Water Supply Fluoridation Census
