Sources of birth and death vital record information

- Birth record: Local health departments have access to the records of births which happen in their jurisdictions for one year after the DOB through Sphere.
- Death records: Local health departments have access to the death certificates of resident deaths through the Vital Records Reports.



Creating cases from import under “Manage Cases”

Process timeline

- Death certificates are filed within 5 days of death.
- DHS sends death certificates to National Center for Health Statistics for ICD-10 coding.
- Once cases are returned to DHS, they are ready for upload to the CRS.
- Cases will be uploaded in one month cohorts based upon the month the death certificate was filed.
- Creation of case from import will be available between 45 and 60 days after the death certificate was filed.
- Example: Death certificates filed in April 2017 will be available for creation through import at the end of May.

Section A1

- Name
- DOB, DOD
- Age
- Race/Hispanic ethnicity
- Sex
- Address

Section A3

- Gestational age
- Birth weight
- Multiple birth
- # of pregnancies
- # of live births
- # of children living
- Prenatal care
- Maternal smoking before/during pregnancy

Fields populated with case import

Section G (wording from death certificate)

- G1: ICD-10 death code
- G2: Immediate cause of death
- G3: Other significant conditions contributing to death
- G4: Injury description
- G5: Official manner of death

Important Tips

1. Year of review will be the year the case was created from import and can be changed.
2. The case type will default to “death”.
3. The case report will appear after it is created. To add to it at another time, save it, and then access through “Manage Cases”.

DATA QUALITY SUMMARY

Why a Data Quality Summary?

- Provides feedback to local team on availability and timeliness of case report variables
- Data quality impacts the ability to translate CDR review into program and policy prevention recommendations

Overview

- Includes case reports from deaths occurring Jan. 1, 2017 – Dec. 31, 2017
- Includes only cases marked as data entry complete
- Does not reflect cases marked data entry complete after March 27, 2018



Data Quality Summary Components

- Overview of 2017 cases
- Timeliness measures among cases with completed data entry
- Data completeness measures, SUID cases
- Data completeness measures, non-SUID cases

Priority Variables Selected

- SUID priority variables - infant priority variable list provided
- Non-SUID priority variables - work group of National Center for Fatality Review and Prevention state CDR stakeholders

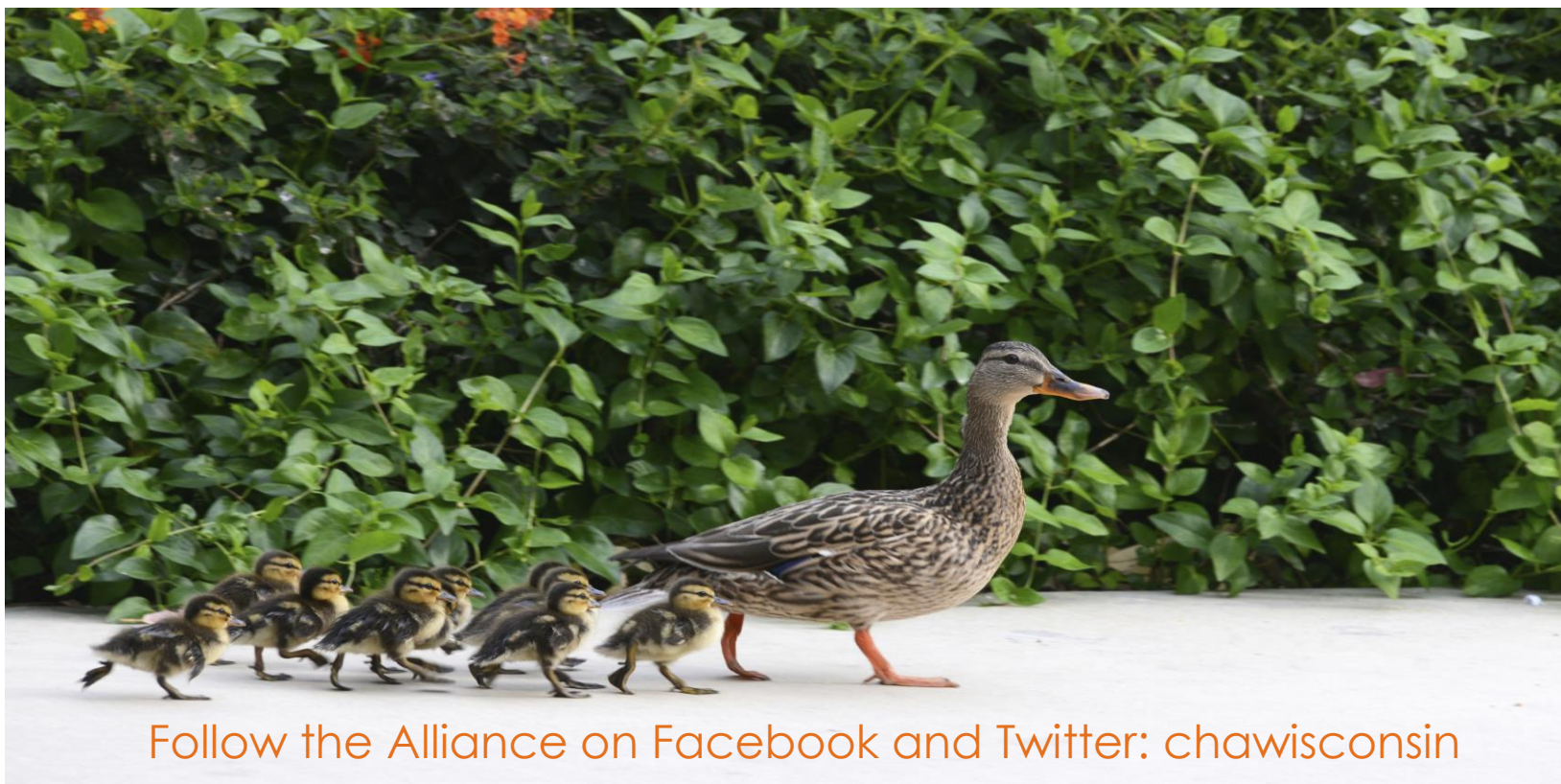
