#### **Child Death Review (CDR)**

Local teams review unexpected child deaths to identify risk factors that inform actionable prevention recommendations.

# Fetal Infant Mortality Review (FIMR)

Local teams review infant deaths to improve birth outcomes and recommend systems change from causes of prematurity, still-birth, sleep-related and more.

# WE IMPLEMENT PREVENTION PROGRAMS



### Sleep Baby Safe (SBS)

A collection of trainings and resources for professionals to use for infant safe sleep outreach and education efforts when working with families and caregivers.

# **Sudden Unexpected Infant Death (SUID) Case Registry**

As the Wisconsin grantee for the Registry, we are able to perform expanded SUID surveillance to monitor trends, enhance community-based prevention and improve data quality and consistency.

# WE MANAGE DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS



#### Data

Helps local CDR and FIMR teams use a standardized data system to improve data quality. Supports program evaluation and identifies trends through data analysis.

#### **Injury prevention**

Offer recommendations and actionable prevention strategies that raise awareness about injury and fatality trends to improve programs, policies and behaviors that keep kids alive.
