

How to get air quality data from sensors on the Love My Air Network dashboard:

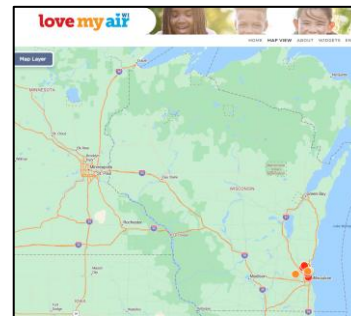
Purpose: View hyper local data in real-time and view hyper-local data from sensors over the last 7 days.

Note: You can only get data from the last 7 days, you cannot go back more than 7 days.

Step 1:

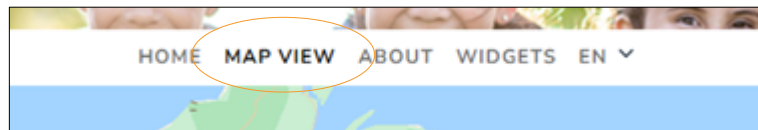
Open the “Love My Air” dashboard.

Step 2:

Select ‘Map View’.

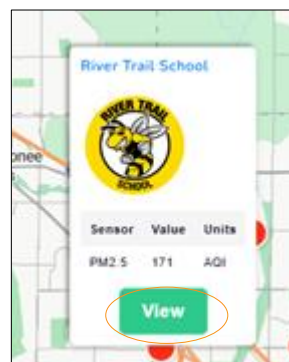


Tip: If your school has a sensor on the map, select ‘home’ and find your school’s logo. **Click the logo and skip** to step 4.

Step 3:

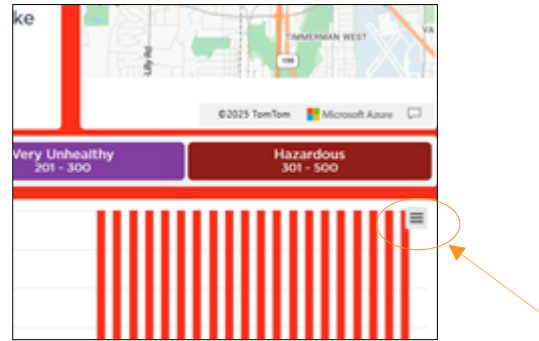
Find the sensor closest to you.

Hover your mouse over the sensor you want data from. Click ‘View’.



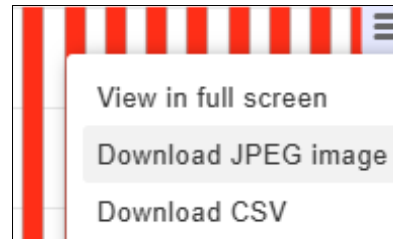
Step 4:

Click on the **3 lines** in the upper-right-hand corner of the data bars.

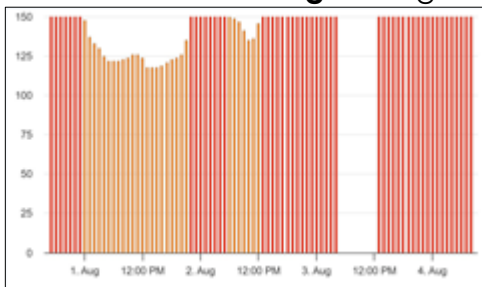


Step 5:

- Click the way you would like to 'see' the data.



- '**Download JPEG image**' will give you an image of the data bars.



- '**Download CSV**' will give you the data in a spreadsheet.
