

OUTREACH OFFERINGS FOR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS

The Wisconsin Medical Home Initiative offers virtual or onsite education for clinical care teams and professionals on medical home topics. Outreach is guided by policy statements or clinical reports from the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

Developmental Screening within Well-Child Care*

This 60-minute session, based on the AAP policy statement on developmental screening (2020) is delivered virtually or onsite and is designed to promote the early identification of and timely referral for children with delays. Health care professionals learn about and

receive copies of a validated developmental screening tool, Ages and Stages Questionnaire-3, and a validated autism-specific screening instrument, Modified Checklist for Autism in Toddlers-Revised with Follow-Up. In addition, community partners serving children with delays and their families will share information about their programs.

Pediatric Mental Health Screening Tools*

Based upon the AAP's Mental Health Toolkit (2010) and the AAP policy statement on behavioral health integration into pediatric primary care (2009), this educational opportunity is designed to support health care professionals in behavioral health provision. This one-hour training reviews AAP recommendations on pediatric mental health screening and some of the supporting literature. Professionals learn about two mental health screening tools and are provided with copies of each: Ages and Stages Questionnaire: Social Emotional-Second Edition, and Pediatric Symptom Checklist-17. * The University of Wisconsin-Madison Interprofessional Continuing Education Partnership designates this live activity for a maximum of 1.0 AMA PRA Category Credit, 1.0 ANCC contact hours and .1 CEUs or 1.0 hours.
