WAC's guiding principles:

The guiding principles serve as the core foundation from which the WAC maintains its inherent desire to take control of asthma.

- WAC membership endorses the mission and vision of the coalition and is responsible for its success and failures
- WAC leadership listens to members and external stakeholders and is open to new ideas or ways
 of operating programs
- Communication lines are open and transparent between leadership and membership
- Direct and deliberate actions are required to effectively overcome asthma related health inequities
- WAC utilizes external and internal data to develop, alter or expand programs using evidencebased best practices
- WAC will actively evaluate progress
- WAC is committed to addressing health disparities

Four goals of the Wisconsin Asthma Plan:

- 1. **Routine health care** Increase implementation of current NIH asthma guidelines for optimal diagnosis and management of asthma by health care providers
- 2. **Pharmaceutical care** Increase appropriate use of comprehensive pharmacologic therapy for long–term asthma
- 3. **Education** Increase education that fosters a partnership among the patient, his or her family, caregivers and clinicians
- 4. **Environment** Improve environmental control measures to avoid or eliminate factors that precipitate asthma symptoms or exacerbations
